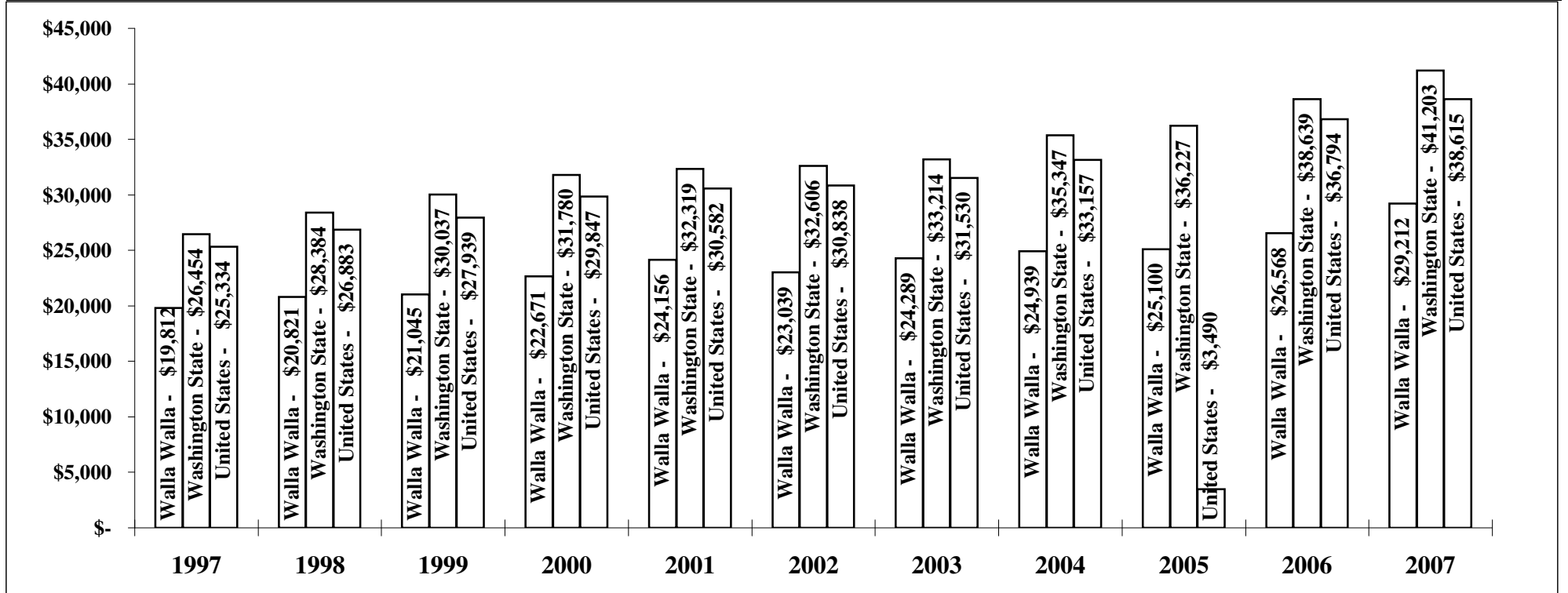

In 2006 Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$26,118. This PCPI ranked 26th in the state and was 68 percent of the state average, \$38,212, and 71 percent of the national average, \$36,714. The 2006 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.2 percent from 2005. The 2005-2006 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent.

In 2007 Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,212. This PCPI ranked 20th in the state and was 71 percent of the state average, \$41,203, and 76 percent of the national average, \$38,615. The 2007 PCPI reflected an increase of 10.0 percent from 2006. The 2006-2007 state change was 6.6 percent and the national change was 4.9 percent. In 1997 the PCPI of Walla Walla was \$19,812 and ranked 27th in the state. The 1997-2007 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 4.3 percent.
