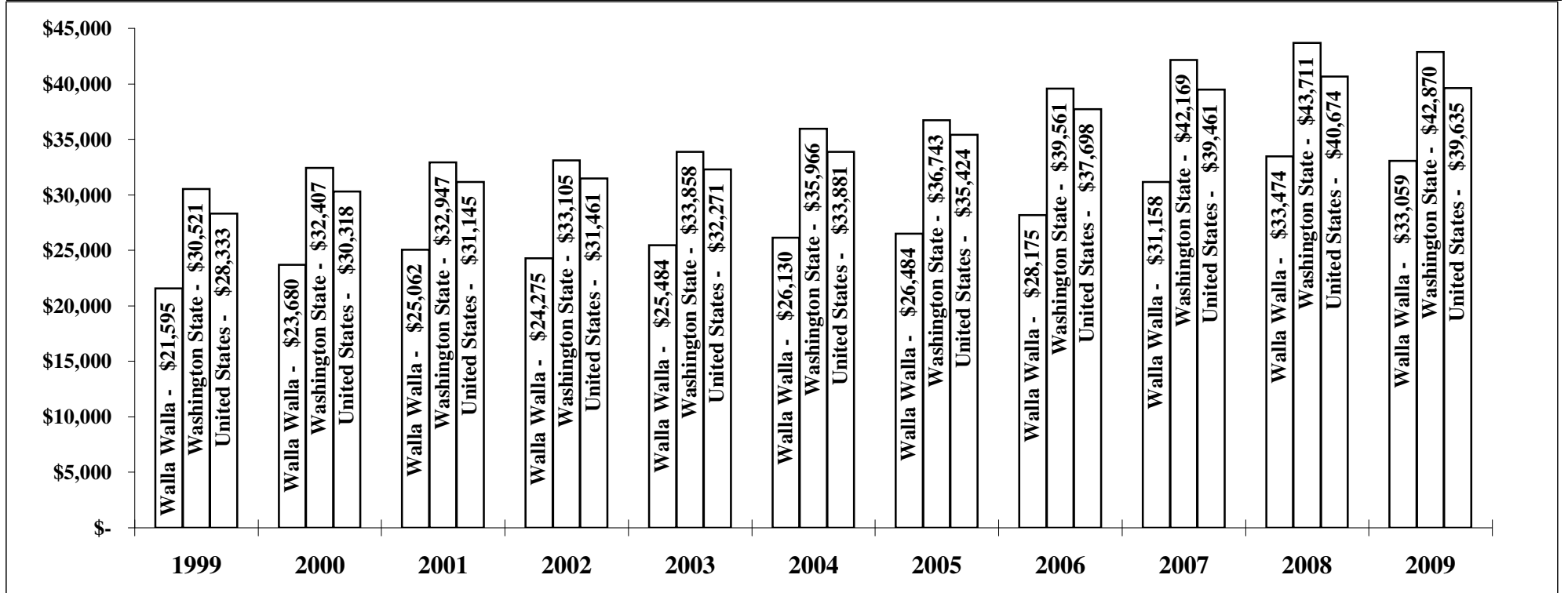

In 2008 Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,474. This PCPI ranked 20th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$43,711, and 82 percent of the national average, \$40,674. The 2008 PCPI reflected an increase of 7.4 percent from 2007. The 2007-2008 state change was 3.7 percent and the national change was 3.1 percent. In 1998 the PCPI of Walla Walla was \$21,096 and ranked 24th in the state. The 1998-2008 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.7 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.3 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

In 2009 Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$33,059. This PCPI ranked 20th in the state and was 77 percent of the state average, \$42,870, and 83 percent of the national average, \$39,635. The 2009 PCPI reflected a decrease of 1.2 percent from 2008. The 2008-2009 state change was -1.9 percent and the national change was -2.6 percent. In 1999 the PCPI of Walla Walla was \$21,595 and ranked 25th in the state. The 1999-2009 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.5 percent and for the nation was 3.4 percent.
