- How and when will you have opportunities to voice your concerns?

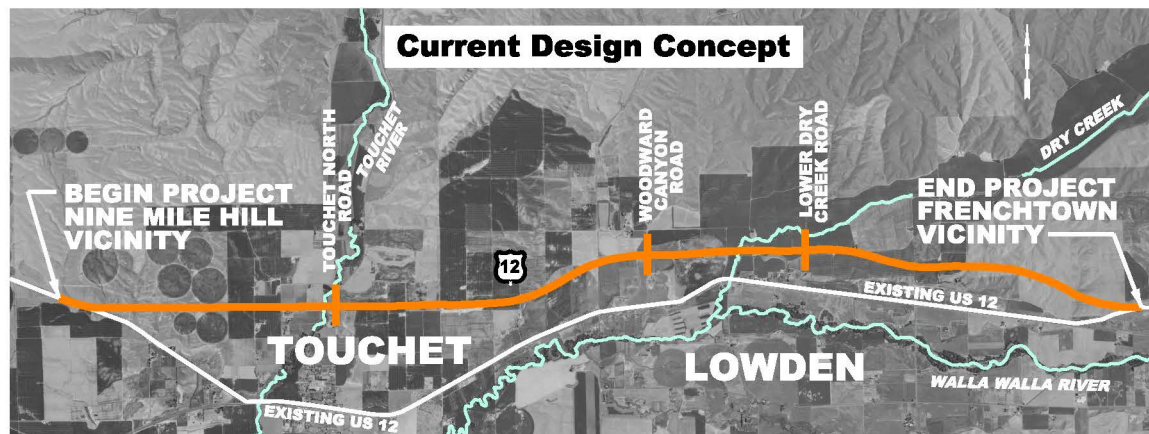

- Access Hearing for US 12 from Woodward Canyon to Frenchtown Vicinity (summer 2017).
- Right-of-Way acquisition begins summer 2017.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in 2019.
