Working Washington Small Business Grants 2.0 (WWSBG2) <u>Guidelines</u>

Purpose of WWSBG2 Funds

The intended outcome of this Working Washington Small Business Grants 2.0 (WWSBG2) program is to support For-Profit Businesses and Non-Profit Business Service Organizations with less than 20 employees that have been impacted by the COVID-19 emergency and to prevent the closure of their business or service organization.

Total Amount of WWSBG2 available for Walla Walla County

A total of approximately \$185,000 in Federal CARES Act funds have been allocated to Walla Walla County.

- \$175,000 allocated to "For-Profit Businesses";
- \$10,000 allocated to "Non-Profit Business Service Organizations" (i.e. Chambers, Direct Marketing Organizations, Tourism Bureaus, etc.); and

Minimum Funding Qualifications for WWSBG2:

- **A.** The business has less than 20 employees. ¹
- **B.** The business is located in Walla Walla County, WA. ¹
- **C.** The business <u>did not already receive</u> a Working Washington Small Business Grant earlier this year. ¹
- **D.** The business was established before January 1, 2020¹
- E. The business is in compliance with the Washington State Department of Labor & Industries laws. 1

Maximum WWSBG2 Fund Request: \$2,500

WWSBG2 Application Period & Submittal Process

The WWSBG2 Application process will open on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at 9:00 AM and close on Tuesday, September 22, 2020 at 4:00 PM. The remaining Funding Schedule timeline is outlined below.

For-Profit Business Applications

For-Profit Business applications will be separated into three (3) "Employment Categories" based on how many employees the business employed as of March 1, 2020 on their application. The three (3) "Employment Categories" are defined below with the allocation of funds for the three (3) "Employment Categories". The three (3) "Employment Categories" will then compete for the allocated grant funds within each "Employment Category".

WWSBG2 Review Process

WWSBG2 is a competitive grant application process with a very limited amount of grant funds available for distribution. Each application will be reviewed and scored by an eight (8) member review panel. Review panel members are listed below.

Application Scoring

Applications will be separated into their respective "Employment Categories" and will be scored on the following information submitted in their application (maximum points possible in "Employment Category 1" is 45 points; "Employment Category 2" is 55 points; and "Employment Category 3" is 75 points):

- 1. Has the business been affected by emergency public health protections in place and/or mandatory closure by executive order due to COVID-19? (10 point maximum is possible in all three (3) "Employment Categories". Points will be given based on Applicants answer and Reviewer's decision)
- 2. Total Number of employees as of March 1, 2020? (5 point maximum in "Employment Category 1"; 10 point maximum in "Employment Category 2"; and 20 point maximum in "Employment Category 3")
- 3. Will the grant funds help retain jobs? (5 point maximum in "Employment Category 1"; 10 point maximum in "Employment Category 2"; and 20 point maximum in "Employment Category 3")
- 4. The business impact to the Walla Walla County economy? (Maximum of 25 points possible in all three (3) "Employment Categories". Points will be given based on Applicants answer and Reviewer's decision)

WWSBG2 Eligible Expenses

<u>Eligible Expenses:</u> Losses that businesses have incurred as a direct result of the emergency and public health declarations and stay-at-home orders due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Eligible Expenses include operational expenses such as rent, utility bills, mortgage payments (associated with the business), and items purchased to protect the public and employees (i.e. protective masks, hand sanitizer, and costs incurred by installing required safety measures to reopen a business).

Important Notes:

- 1. <u>Businesses can not be reimbursed by multiple funders for the same cost (double-dipping), and this principle also applies to any recipients of CARES funding: No duplicate payments or supplanting of other costs are allowed.</u>
- 2. Grant funds can not be used to pay payroll and benefits, travel and associated expenses, taxes, Federal & State expenses (including Federal Taxes), land acquisition, office equipment, software.
