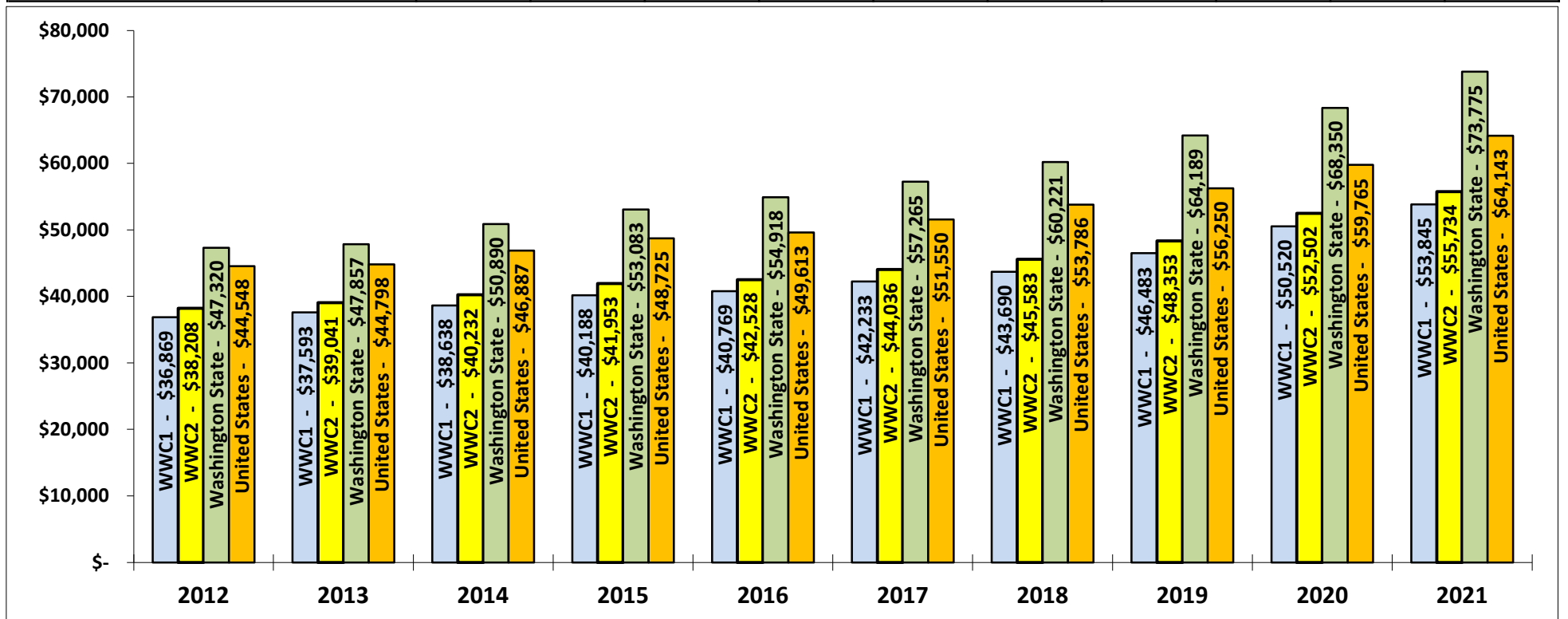

In 2021, Walla Walla had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$53,845. This PCPI ranked 21st in the state and was 73 percent of the state average, \$73,775, and 83.9 percent of the national average, \$64,143. The 2021 PCPI reflected an increase of 6.6 percent from 2020. The 2020–2021 state change was 7.9 percent and the national change was 7.3 percent. In 2011, the PCPI of Walla Walla was \$35,488 and ranked 21st in the state. The 2011–2021 compound annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.3 percent. The compound annual growth rate for the state was 5.3 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.
