INVITATION FOR BID

Sealed proposals will be received for the Taxiway A Reconstruction project, addressed to the Port of Walla Walla, 310 A Street, Walla Walla, WA 99362 until 1:00 pm local time on March 15, 2017, and then will be publicly opened and read. Bids received after the time fixed for the opening will not be considered.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Port Office at 1:00 p.m., local time March 2, 2017 for those interested contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers.

The project consists of, but is not limited to the reconstruction of the existing Taxiway A (approximately 6,400' x 75') and taxiway connectors (approximately 2,125' x 75'). The project includes the removal of the existing asphalt surface averaging 4 - 6" thick and removal of the underlying 6 - 8" Portland Cement Concrete pavement. Construction of the new pavement section will consist of excavation, placement of base courses, placement of cement treated base (CTB), soil cement base and bituminous surface course. The project will also include re-grading of the adjacent Taxiway Safety Areas (TSAs), re-grading a portion of the Runway Safety Area (RSA), the installation of a new Medium Intensity Taxiway Lighting System (MITL), installation of new electrical regulators, new lighted guidance signs, new Runway End Identifier Lights (REILS) for Runway 2, re-routing of the existing sanitary sewer (approximately 3,000'), relocation of the existing sanitary sewer flow meter, as well as drainage improvements throughout the project site.

Each bidder shall furnish the Statement of Bidders Pre-Qualifications to the OWNER with satisfactory evidence of his competency to perform the work contemplated with the bid.

The Port of Walla Walla reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, waive any informalities, or irregularities, postpone the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, as further described in the contract documents, and accept the proposal that is in the best interest of the Port of Walla Walla.
